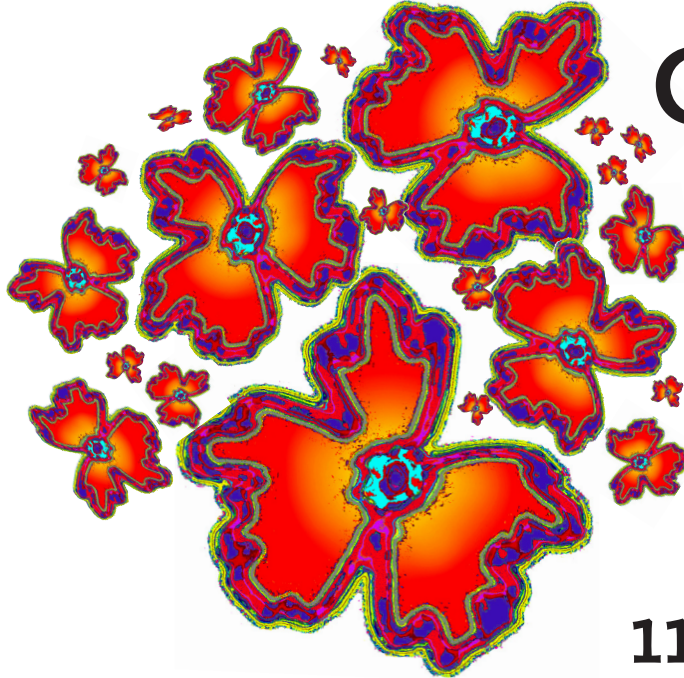

The Capay Valley

The Capay Valley, located west of Woodland on Highway 16, is an agricultural valley. Farms produce organic fruits and vegetables, orchards produce almonds and walnuts, vineyards produce wine grapes, and rangeland supports cattle. There are several small towns, beginning with Esparto at the southern end of the Capay Valley, continuing through Capay, Brooks, Guinda, then to Rumsey at the northern end.
